W.S. 41-3-110(a) and 41-3-111 are amended 6 7 to read: 8 9 41-3-110. Right to acquire temporary water rights; application; restrictions; fee. 10 11 12 (a) Any person shall have the right to acquire by 13 purchase, gift or lease the right to the use of water which 14 may be embraced in any adjudicated or valid unadjudicated 15 water right, or any portion thereof, for a period of not to 16 exceed two (2) five (5) years, for highway construction or

10 right acquired by any person under this act who cannot 11 satisfy in full his the senior right in full during the 12 time said temporary user is diverting water under its temporary water right shall have the absolute right upon 13 14 demand being made upon the appropriate state water commissioner to cause such diversion to be shut off until 15 16 such time as said owner's water right is satisfied, or 17 until it is proven that the shutting down of the diversion has no effect upon owner's right. 18
