## A BILL

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-13-105(b) is amended to read:

10 **39-13-105.** Exemptions.

- 12 (b) The exemption for veterans is limited to an
- 13 annual exemption of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) six

14 thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) of assessed value.

3 Subject to subsection (b) of this section, there 4 is appropriated eight million two hundred thousand dollars 5 (\$8,200,000.00) from the general fund to state the treasurer to be expended only for purposes of providing 6 reimbursements to county treasurers for the veterans' tax 7 8 exemption provided by W.S. 39-13-102(k). as appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 9 10 and any unobligated, unexpended other purpose remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 11 12 by law on June 30, 2027.

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14 (b) The appropriation in subsection (a) of this section shall be reduced by one dollar (\$1.00) for every 15 16 one dollar (\$1.00) appropriated to the state treasurer 17 during the 2024 budget session in excess of eleven million five hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred thirty-nine 18 19 dollars (\$11,545,839.00) of for purposes providing 20 reimbursements to counties under W.S. 39-13-102(k).

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22 (c) It is the intent of the legislature that the 23 appropriation in subsection (a) of this section be included

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1	in the state treasurer's standard budget for the
2	immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.
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4	Section 3. This act shall apply to ad valorem tax
5	assessed on and after January 1, 2025.

7	Section 4. The department of revenue shall promulgate
8	all rules necessary to implement the provisions of this
9	act.

13	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
14	section, this act is effective January 1, 2025.
15	
16	(b) Sections 4 and 5 of this act are effective
17	immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
18	bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
19	the Wyoming Constitution.
