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7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. W.S. 1-3-105 by creating a new subsection
10	(c) is amended to read:
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11-3-105. Actions other than recovery of real2property.

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4 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section or 5 W.S. 1-3-107, a civil action based upon an act, error or omission against a minor in the provision of gender 6 transition services shall be brought not later than the 7 8 minor's twenty-first birthday. For purposes of this subsection "gender transition services" means any medical 9 10 or surgical service provided or performed for the purpose of assisting a person with a physical gender transition, 11 including without limitation inpatient and outpatient 12 hospital services, puberty-blocking drugs, cross-sex 13 hormones, genital or nongenital gender reassignment surgery 14 15 or other related services provided by a health care 16 provider as defined in W.S. 1-1-130(b)(i).

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18 Section 2. This act applies to causes of action 19 arising on and after July 1, 2024.

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21 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
