(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of
the law, not more than three (3) charter schools
shall be authorized to operate by an entity other
than a school district board, prior to July 1,
2026—July 1, 2024. The three (3) charter schools
authorized by the state loan and investment board
shall count towards the three (3) schools
authorized to operate under this subsection. In
the event a charter school previously authorized
by the state loan and investment board closes for
any reason, the Wyoming charter school
authorizing board may approve a new charter
school.

(c) Except as provided under subjection subsection (b) of this section, but not prior to July 1, 2026 July 1, 2024, not more than one (1) three (3) additional charter school schools shall be authorized to operate by an entity other than a school district, prior to July 1, 2028.

(d) Not later than October 1, 2023, and each October 1 thereafter through October 1,

1	2028, the state superintendent, in consultation
2	with the state construction department, shall
3	provide to the joint education interim committee
4	and the joint appropriations committee a report
5	identifying the fiscal impact on the school
6	foundation program account, the education
7	resource block grant model as defined by W.S.
8	21-13-101(a)(xiv) and the school capital
9	construction account as a result of the operation
10	of the three (3) charter schools approved by the
11	state loan and investment board and the $\frac{1}{2}$
12	three (3) charter school schools which may be
13	approved by the Wyoming charter school
14	authorizing board. The reports shall specify the
15	fiscal impact at the district and the school
16	level and shall at minimum identify the amounts
17	generated under W.S. 21-3-314(c), as amended by
18	this act, and amounts for facility needs,
19	including but not limited to lease amounts,
20	expenditure or requests for major building and
21	facility repair and replacement under W.S.
22	21-15-109 and any other requests related to
23	capital construction projects.

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Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 2

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 3

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 4

5 Constitution.
