FISCAL NOTE

The State Construction Department indicated an indeterminable non-administrative fiscal impact.

The University of Wyoming indicated an indeterminable but likely significant non-administrative fiscal impact to comply with the requirements of the bill. The University also indicated administrative impacts are anticipated but unknown at this time.

The Wyoming Community College Commission indicated no significant fiscal or personnel impact to the agency. However, the Commission indicated there would be an indeterminable fiscal impact to Wyoming community colleges to comply with the requirements of the bill.

The Department of Administration and Information indicated no significant fiscal or personnel impact.
