Source of expenditure increase:

This bill creates the Joint and Standing Committee on Federal Review. The expenditure increase in the table above is the estimated expenditure increase to create the proposed committee.

Assumptions:

It is assumed that the proposed Joint and Standing Committee on Federal Review would have 14 committee members.

It is assumed the proposed committee would cost \$55,000 per fiscal year. \$55,000 is the average amount budgeted for the current 14-member standing committees in the Legislative budget for the 2025-26 biennium (rounded).

The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint members to the proposed Joint and Standing Committee on Federal Review not later than January 6, 2025. With this date, it is assumed that expenditures related to the proposed Committee would begin in FY 2026.

It is assumed there will be sufficient funding budgeted in 2025-26 biennium Legislative budget to pay for the cost of the proposed committee in FY 2026.

This bill also puts all current standing committees into statute. It is assumed that putting the current standing committees into statute would have no fiscal impact.
