Description of Appropriation:

This bill creates the rural attorney recruitment program. The program provides up to five equal annual incentive payments to qualified participants who have committed to practicing law full-time in eligible counties. The program will support five practicing attorneys and the Supreme Court indicates the remainder of the appropriation will be expended in fiscal years 2027, 2028, and 2029. Any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining will revert to the GENERAL FUND on June 30, 2029.

There is no significant fiscal or personnel impact to the Board of Law Examiners.
