

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact is indeterminable.

This bill amends the mandatory school attendance age for kindergarten from seven to six and may increase a school district's average daily membership due to an increase in the number of students required to attend school earlier than currently required. The Department of Education indicates approximately 340 students enter kindergarten at age seven and approximately 40 students enter first grade at age seven without previously being enrolled in a Wyoming public school. An increase in average daily membership, due students attending school earlier than currently required, may increase a school district's foundation program amount computed by the education resource block grant model, resulting in an indeterminable fiscal impact.
