A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state lands; removing an inconsistent
2 legal description of the Sutton state archaeological site;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-8-1501(c)(iii) is amended to read:

9 **36-8-1501. State park designation; state historic**
10 **site designation; state archeological site designation;**
11 **state recreation area designation.**

13 (c) In addition to state archaeological sites
14 designated in other statutes, the following lands are

1 designated as state archaeological sites and the department
2 shall by rule specify the legal description of the sites:

4 (iii) The lands in Platte County managed by the
5 department as of July 1, 2023 as Sutton state
6 archaeological site. ~~The site shall consist of the
7 following real property of forty six and three hundred
8 eighty two thousandths (46.382) acres in section 6,
9 township 27, range 65, mineral survey no. 196, patented
10 claims: Mollie Gibson, Crown and 1901.~~

11

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
15 Constitution.
