- 14 of the Wyoming constitution, a person shall not be a
- 15 candidate for the state legislature from a legislative

1 district unless he has been a resident of that legislative

2 district for at least one (1) year next preceding his

3 before the date of the applicable general election. In any

4 general election year in which a plan of legislative

5 districts is required but has not been enacted into law at

6 least one (1) year prior to the applicable filing periods,

7 a person may be a candidate for the state legislature from

8 a legislative district if he:

10 (ii) Has been a resident of a county for at

11 least one (1) year next preceding his before the date of

12 the applicable general election in which any portion of

13 that legislative district is located.

15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
