Gender reassignment procedures for 2 children prohibited. 3 4 (a) As used in this section: 5 (i) "Child" means a person who is younger than б 7 eighteen (18) years of age; 8 9 (ii) "Physician" means any person licensed to 10 practice medicine in this state by the state board of medicine under the Medical Practice Act. 11 12 (b) No physician shall, for purposes of transitioning 13 a child's biological sex to a sex different than the sex 14 assigned at birth as determined by the sex organs, 15 16 chromosomes and endogenous profiles of the child, or for 17 purposes of affirming the child's perception of the child's sex if that perception is inconsistent with the child's 18 19 biological sex: 20 21 (i) Perform a surgery that sterilizes the child, castration, vasectomy, hysterectomy, 22 including
