1 AN ACT relating to the University of Wyoming board of trustees; increasing the members of the board of trustees; 2 3 providing for election of trustees as specified; specifying 4 election requirements; making conforming amendments; 5 specifying requirements for the initial election and 6 initial terms of elected trustees; specifying expiration of 7 existing appointed trustee terms; specifying requirements for appointment and terms of appointed trustees after the 8 9 2024 general election; and providing for an effective date. 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 11 12 13 Section 1. 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14 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law for the initial trustees appointed by the governor after the 2024 15 16 general election, the term of office of the appointed 17 trustees appointed is six (6) years. During each session of the legislature, the governor shall nominate, and with the 18 19 advice and consent of the senate, appoint successors to 20 those appointed trustees whose term of office has expired 21 or will expire before the next session of the legislature. Any vacancy in the board of appointed trustees caused by 22 death, resignation, removal from the state or otherwise, 23

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shall be filled by appointment by the governor as provided 1 2 in W.S. 28-12-101. No member of the faculty, while holding 3 that position, shall ever be appointed a trustee. The 4 governor may remove any appointed trustee as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. 5 б 7 (b) Effective July 1, 1979 Except as otherwise 8 provided by law for the trustees appointed by the governor after the 2024 general election, appointments and terms for 9 10 the appointed trustees shall be in accordance with W.S. 11 28-12-101 through 28-12-103. 12 (c) Except as otherwise provided by law for the 13 initial elected trustees, the term of office of the elected 14 15 trustees is four (4) years. Any vacancy under the 16 circumstances provided by W.S. 22-18-101 of an elected 17 trustee shall be filled within thirty (30) days by action of the remaining trustees. A person chosen to fill a 18 19 vacancy shall serve until the next election of University 20 of Wyoming trustees. An election shall then be held to 21 fill any unexpired term.

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(a) Any vacancy in any other elective office in the 7 state except representative in congress, or the elected 8 9 board of trustees of a school or district, community 10 college district or the University of Wyoming, shall be filled by the governing body, or as otherwise provided in 11 12 this section, by appointment of a temporary successor. The person appointed shall serve until a successor for the 13 remainder of the unexpired term is elected at the next 14 general election and takes office on the first Monday of 15 16 the following January. Provided, if a vacancy in a four 17 (4) year term of office occurs in the term's second or 18 subsequent years after the first day for filing an 19 application for nomination pursuant to W.S. 22-5-209, no 20 election to fill the vacancy shall be held and the 21 temporary successor appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term. The following apply: 22

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1 (b) The trustees of a school or community college 2 district or the University of Wyoming shall fill a an 3 elected office vacancy in office by temporary appointment 4 in a manner provided by law. If the trustees of a school or community college district or the University of Wyoming 5 fail to appoint a person qualified to hold the office to 6 fill a an elected office vacancy within thirty (30) days 7 8 from the date the vacancy occurs, or if, for any reason, 9 the entire membership of the board of trustees of a school 10 or community college district or the University of Wyoming 11 is depleted, the board of county commissioners of the 12 county or counties involved, within ten (10) days of either occurrence, shall appoint a person qualified to hold the 13 office to fill each elected office vacancy until the next 14 election at which time an election shall be held to fill 15 16 the unexpired term, and each appointee shall serve until 17 his successor is elected and qualified. Each appointee shall be a resident of the appointment district, trustee 18 19 residence area, or election subdistrict, if any, previously 20 represented. 21

10	(a) The terms of the seven (7) University of Wyoming
11	trustees elected at the first regular election after the
12	effective date of this act shall begin as provided by W.S.
13	22-22-102(a). The four (4) elected trustees receiving the
14	highest number of votes at the election shall serve four
15	(4) year terms and the elected trustees receiving the next
16	three (3) highest number of votes at the election shall
17	serve two (2) year terms. Thereafter, all terms shall be
18	for four (4) years in accordance with W.S. 21-17-202(b).
19	
20	(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law,
21	the terms of the twelve (12) existing appointed trustees
22	shall expire at 11:59 a.m. on the first day in December

23 following the 2024 general election. As provided by W.S.

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1	28-12-101, the governor shall appoint seven (7) trustees to
2	the University of Wyoming board of trustees. As designated
3	by the governor, four (4) appointed trustees shall serve
4	six (6) year terms and three (3) appointed trustees shall
5	serve three (3) year terms. Thereafter, all terms shall be
6	for six (6) years in accordance with W.S. 21-17-202(a).
7	

8 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 9 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 11 Constitution.
