Compensation for advising on veterans 2 benefits prohibited; limitations; penalties; definitions. 3 4 (a) No person shall receive compensation for advising or assisting any person with regard to any federal or state 5 veterans benefits matter, except as permitted under federal 6 law and as provided in this section. 7 8 9 person shall receive compensation (b) No for referring any person to another person to advise or assist 10 11 the person with any veterans benefits matter. 12 13 (c) A person seeking to receive compensation for 14 advising or assisting any person with any veterans benefits matter shall, before rendering any services, memorialize 15 16 all terms regarding the person's payment of fees for 17 services rendered in a written agreement, signed by both parties, that adheres to all criteria specified in 38 18 19 C.F.R. 14.636.

(d) No person shall receive any compensation for any services rendered before the date on which a notice of disagreement is filed with respect to the person's case.

2 (e) No person shall guarantee, either directly or by 3 implication, that any person is certain to receive specific 4 veterans benefits or that any person is certain to receive specific level, percentage or 5 amount of veterans a benefits. б 7 (f) No person shall receive excessive or unreasonable 8 9 fees as compensation for advising or assisting any person 10 with any veterans benefits matter. The factors specified in 38 C.F.R. 14.636 shall govern determinations of whether a 11 12 fee is excessive or unreasonable. 13 14 (g) No person shall advise or assist for compensation any person concerning any veterans benefits matter without 15 16 clearly providing, at the outset of the business relationship, the following disclosure, both orally and in 17 18 writing: 19 20 "This business is not sponsored by, or affiliated 21 with, the United States Department of Veterans 22 Affairs, the Wyoming Military Department or any 23 other federally chartered veterans service

Other organizations, including but 2 not limited to the Wyoming Military Department, 3 your local county veterans service agency and 4 other federally chartered veterans service 5 organizations, may be able to provide you with this service free of charge. Products or services б 7 offered by this business are not necessarily 8 endorsed by any of these organizations. You may 9 qualify for other veterans benefits beyond the 10 benefits for which you are receiving services 11 here."

13 The written disclosure shall appear in not less than twelve 14 (12) point font and shall appear in a readily noticeable 15 and identifiable place in the person's agreement with the 16 person seeking services. The person shall verbally 17 acknowledge understanding of the oral disclosure and shall sign the document in which the written disclosure appears, 18 19 to represent understanding of the disclosure. The person 20 offering services shall retain a copy of the written 21 disclosure while providing veterans' benefits services for compensation to the person and for at least one (1) year 22

1 after the date which the service relationship on 2 terminates. 3 4 (h) No person shall advertise for compensation 5 services in any veterans' benefits matters without including the following disclosure: б 7 8 "This business is not sponsored by, or affiliated 9 with, the United States Department of Veterans 10 Affairs, the Wyoming Military Department or any 11 other federally chartered veterans service 12 organization. Other organizations, including but not limited to the Wyoming Military Department, 13 14 your local county veterans service agency and 15 other federally chartered veterans service 16 organizations, may be able to provide you with 17 these services free of charge. Products or services offered by this business 18 are not 19 necessarily endorsed by of any these 20 organizations. You may qualify for other veterans benefits beyond the services that this business 21 22 offers."

If the advertisement is printed, including but not limited 1 2 to advertisements visible to internet users, the disclosure 3 shall appear in a readily visible place on the 4 advertisement. If the advertisement is verbal, the spoken disclosure shall 5 statement of the be clear and 6 intelligible. 7 8 (j) A violation of this section shall be an unlawful 9 practice and a violation of W.S. 40-12-105. 10 (k) As used in this section: 11 12 (i) "Veterans benefits matter" means the 13 preparation, presentation or prosecution of any claim 14 affecting any person who has filed or expressed an intent 15 16 to file a claim for any state or federal benefit, program, 17 service, commodity, function or status, entitlement to which is determined under the 18 laws and regulations 19 administered by the United States department of veterans 20 affairs or the Wyoming military department pertaining to 21 veterans, their dependents, their survivors and any other 22 person eligible for such benefits;
