1 AN ACT relating to mine product taxes; providing an 2 exemption for the production of crude oil and natural gas 3 produced through enhanced oil recovery techniques and using Wyoming carbon dioxide; specifying conditions for the 4 5 exemption; requiring reports; providing definitions; making б conforming amendments; providing a sunset date for the 7 exemption; and providing for an effective date. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-14-204(a)(iii) and (iv) and 12 39-14-205 by creating a new subsection (q) are amended to 13 read: 14 15 39-14-204. Tax rate.

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2	(a) Except as otherwise provided by this section and
3	W.S. 39-14-205, the total severance tax on crude oil, lease
4	condensate or natural gas shall be six percent (6%),
5	comprising one and one-half percent (1.5%) imposed by the
6	Wyoming constitution article 15, section 19 and the
7	remaining amount imposed by Wyoming statute. The tax shall
8	be distributed as provided in W.S. 39-14-211 and is imposed
9	as follows:
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11	(iii) Two percent (2%) <u>, except as provided in</u>
12	<u>W.S. 39-14-205(q)</u> ; plus

14	(iv) Two percent (2%) <u>,</u> except as provided in
15	W.S. 39-14-205(n) and (q).

19	(q) Crude oil and natural gas production resulting
20	from oil and gas that is produced by means of enhanced oil
21	and gas recovery is exempt from one-half (1/2) of the
22	severance taxes imposed under W.S. 39-14-204(a)(iii) and

2	39-14-204(a)(iv), subject to the following:

б	(A) "Carbon capture, utilization and
7	storage technology" means technology that has the principal
8	purpose of capturing, reusing, storing, sequestering or
9	using carbon dioxide emissions to prevent carbon dioxide
10	from entering the atmosphere;

12	(B) "Enhanced oil and gas recovery" means
13	all existing and future technologies or methods to recover
14	oil and gas beyond traditional primary and secondary
15	recovery methods, including technology to optimize
16	development and recovery of oil and gas resources in new
16 17	development and recovery of oil and gas resources in new fields.

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1	(iii) To qualify for the exemption under this
2	subsection, the crude oil and natural gas shall be produced
3	by means of enhanced oil and gas recovery from projects
4	using carbon capture, utilization and storage technology;
5	
6	(iv) The carbon dioxide used in the enhanced oil
7	and gas recovery to produce crude oil and natural gas shall
8	be from a carbon dioxide source originating within the
9	state of Wyoming;
10	
11	(v) To ensure that the crude oil and natural gas
12	production by means of enhanced oil and gas recovery
13	satisfies the conditions of this subsection, the department
14	may consult with the public service commission and the
15	Wyoming oil and gas conservation commission before
16	approving the exemption under this subsection;
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18	(vi) The department may promulgate rules as
19	necessary to implement this subsection;

21	(vii) The exemption available under this
22	subsection shall be available to a taxpayer for all

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1	qualifying production by means of enhanced oil and gas
2	recovery that is completed before July 1, 2032;
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4	(viii) Not later than November 1 of each year,
5	the department shall report to the joint revenue interim
6	committee and the joint minerals, business and economic
7	development interim committee on the use of the exemption
8	under this subsection and the associated revenue impacts.
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10	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
