A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to propose a

2 constitutional amendment identifying the source of political

3 contributions as specified.

4

5 WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has ruled that

6 Congress and the states lack authority to ban independent

7 corporate expenditures to political campaigns for public

8 office, relying on the concept that the spending of money to

9 elect a candidate is protected speech; and

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11 WHEREAS, this United States Supreme Court precedent has

12 allowed the creation of super political action committees in

13 campaigns for public office, which super political action

14 committees have made unprecedented campaign expenditures

15 whose source cannot be readily traced to natural persons; and

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2 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Wyoming has grave

3 concerns that corporations, unions and organizations have

4 abilities not enjoyed by natural persons including perpetual

5 life and enhanced accumulation of assets, which may enable

6 these entities to financially overwhelm individual natural

7 persons in the political process; and

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9 WHEREAS, Congress, state legislatures and local legislative

10 bodies should have the authority to require the

11 identification of campaign expenditures and to limit

12 expenditures by entities that are not natural persons; and

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14 WHEREAS, a constitutional amendment would control over United

15 States Supreme Court precedent interpreting the United States

16 Constitution.

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18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE

19 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

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21 **Section 1.** That the Legislature of the State of Wyoming

22 respectfully urges the Congress of the United States to

23 propose and send to the states for ratification an amendment

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1 to the United States Constitution to allow the public

2 identification of the source of political contributions or

3 expenditures for or against any candidate and to limit or

4 prohibit corporations and other entities that are not natural

5 persons from making campaign contributions for or against any

6 candidate. Political expenditures by organizations that are

7 comprised of natural persons and that publicly identify their

8 members and donors should not be restricted.

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10 Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming

11 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the

12 United States, to the President of the Senate and the Speaker

13 of the House of Representatives of the United States Congress

14 and to the Wyoming Congressional Delegation.
