State employee leave for volunteer fire or volunteer EMS.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;  
2 providing state employees leave to serve as volunteer  
3 firefighters and volunteer emergency medical technicians as  
4 specified; requiring rulemaking; and providing for  
5 effective dates.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-107 is created to read:

10

11 **9-3-107. Leave for volunteer firefighters and**  
12 **volunteer emergency medical technicians.**

13

14 Every state officer and employee shall receive up to  
15 twenty-four (24) hours of leave with pay during each

1 calendar year to use when the state officer or employee is  
2 absent from work due to service as a volunteer firefighter  
3 or volunteer emergency medical technician in the state of  
4 Wyoming. For purposes of this section, "volunteer  
5 firefighter" means as defined by W.S. 35-9-616(a)(x) and  
6 "volunteer emergency medical technician" means as defined  
7 by W.S. 35-9-616(a)(viii).

9 **Section 2.** The department of administration and  
10 information shall promulgate all rules necessary to  
11 implement this act.

12

13 **Section 3.**

14

15 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of  
16 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2024.

17

18 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective  
19 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
20 bill to become a law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
21 the Wyoming Constitution.
