A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; inserting and  
2 amending offenses for which convicted offenders must  
3 register as a sex offender; repealing a definition  
4 associated with sex offender registration; and providing  
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-19-302(g) through (j) is amended to  
10 read:

12 **7-19-302. Registration of offenders; procedure;**  
13 **verification; fees.**

15 (g) For an offender convicted of a violation of W.S.  
16 6-2-316(a)(i) and (iv), 6-2-705, 6-4-303(b)(iv) or W.S.

1 6-4-304(b) if the victim was a minor, 18 U.S.C. §§ 2252B,  
2 2252C, 2424 and 2425, an offense in another jurisdiction  
3 containing the same or similar elements, or arising out of  
4 the same or similar facts or circumstances as a criminal  
5 offense specified in this subsection or an attempt or  
6 conspiracy to commit any of the offenses specified in this  
7 subsection, the division shall annually verify the accuracy  
8 of the offender's registered address, and the offender  
9 shall annually report, in person, his current address to  
10 the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides,  
11 during the period in which he is required to register.  
12 During the annual in-person verification, the sheriff shall  
13 photograph the offender. Confirmation of the in-person  
14 verification required under this subsection, along with the  
15 photograph of the offender, shall be transmitted by the  
16 sheriff to the division within three (3) working days. Any  
17 person under this subsection who has not established a  
18 residence or is transient, and who is reporting to the  
19 sheriff as required under subsection (e) of this section,  
20 shall be deemed in compliance with the address verification  
21 requirements of this section.

1           (h) For an offender convicted of a violation of W.S.  
2 6-2-304(a)(iii) if the victim was at least fourteen (14)  
3 years of age, W.S. 6-2-314(a)(ii) and (iii), 6-2-315(a)(i)  
4 and (iii), W.S. 6-2-315(a)(iv) if the victim was thirteen  
5 (13) through fifteen (15) years of age, W.S. 6-2-316(a)(ii)  
6 if the actor was not more than eight (8) years older than  
7 the victim, W.S. 6-2-317(a)(i) and (ii) or 6-2-318, W.S.  
8 6-2-706, W.S. 6-4-102 if the person solicited was a minor,  
9 W.S. 6-4-103 if the person enticed or compelled was a  
10 minor, W.S. 6-4-302(a)(i) if the offense involves the use  
11 of a minor in a sexual performance or W.S. 6-4-303(b)(i)  
12 through (iii), 18 U.S.C. § 2251, an offense in another  
13 jurisdiction containing the same or similar elements, or  
14 arising out of the same or similar facts or circumstances  
15 as a criminal offense specified in this subsection, an  
16 attempt or conspiracy to commit any of the offenses  
17 specified in this subsection, or any offense enumerated in  
18 subsection (g) of this section if the offender was  
19 previously convicted of any offense enumerated in  
20 subsection (g) of this section, the division shall verify  
21 the accuracy of the offender's registered address, and the  
22 offender shall report, in person, his current address to  
23 the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides,

1 every six (6) months after the date of the initial release  
2 or commencement of parole. If the offender's appearance  
3 has changed substantially, and in any case at least  
4 annually, the sheriff shall photograph the offender.  
5 Confirmation of the in-person verification required by this  
6 subsection, and any new photographs of the offender, shall  
7 be transmitted by the sheriff to the division within three  
8 (3) working days. Any person under this subsection who has  
9 not established a residence or is transient, and who is  
10 reporting to the sheriff as required under subsection (e)  
11 of this section, shall be deemed in compliance with the  
12 address verification requirements of this section.

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14 (j) For an offender convicted of a violation of W.S.  
15 6-2-201 if the victim was a minor, W.S. 6-2-302 or 6-2-303,  
16 W.S. 6-2-304(a)(iii) if the victim was under fourteen (14)  
17 years of age, W.S. 6-2-314(a)(i), W.S. 6-2-314(a)(ii) and  
18 (iii) if the victim was less than thirteen (13) years of  
19 age, W.S. 6-2-315(a)(ii), W.S. 6-2-315(a)(iii) and (iv) if  
20 the victim was less than thirteen (13) years of age, W.S.  
21 6-2-316(a)(ii) and (iii) 6-2-316(a)(ii) if the actor was  
22 more than eight (8) years older than the victim, W.S.  
23 6-2-316(a)(iii), W.S. 6-2-702 or 6-2-703, W.S. 6-4-402, 18

1 U.S.C. § 2245, or an offense in another jurisdiction  
2 containing the same or similar elements, or arising out of  
3 the same or similar facts or circumstances as a criminal  
4 offense specified in this subsection, an attempt or  
5 conspiracy to commit any of the offenses specified in this  
6 subsection, any offense enumerated in subsection (h) of  
7 this section if the offender was previously convicted of  
8 any offense enumerated in subsection (g) of this section or  
9 any offense enumerated in subsection (g) or (h) of this  
10 section if the offender was previously convicted of any  
11 offense enumerated in subsection (h) of this section, the  
12 division shall verify the accuracy of the offender's  
13 registered address, and the offender shall report, in  
14 person, his current address to the sheriff in the county in  
15 which the offender resides every three (3) months after the  
16 date of the initial release or commencement of parole. If  
17 the offender's appearance has changed substantially, and in  
18 any case at least annually, the sheriff shall photograph  
19 the offender. Confirmation of the in-person verification  
20 required by this subsection, and any new photographs of the  
21 offender, shall be transmitted by the sheriff to the  
22 division within three (3) working days. Any person under  
23 this subsection who has not established a residence or is

1 transient, and who is reporting to the sheriff as required  
2 under subsection (e) of this section, shall be deemed in  
3 compliance with the address verification requirements of  
4 this section.

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6 **Section 2.** W.S. 7-19-301(a)(iv) is repealed.

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8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
