## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; authorizing construction of designated water projects; describing 2 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for 3 4 projects; providing grants; providing appropriations; amending the sponsor's contingency fund; amending amounts 5 and terms of appropriations for specified prior projects; 6 7 repealing the sunset for the small water projects program; transferring funds from water development account I to 8 9 water development account II; transferring funds from the 10 general fund to water development accounts I and II; and 11 providing for an effective date.
