A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to marketing homemade goods; providing for
2 the sale of homemade meat products as specified; providing
3 a delayed effective date pending certification by the
4 governor based on federal action; providing a definition;
5 authorizing rulemaking; and providing for an effective
6 date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-49-102(a) by creating a new
11 paragraph (xiii) and by renumbering (xiii) as (xiv) and
12 11-49-103(c)(v) by creating a new subparagraph (G) and by
13 creating new subsections (n) and (o) are amended to read:

1 **11-49-102. Definitions.**

2

3 (a) As used in this act:

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5 (xiii) "Custom slaughter facility" means a
6 slaughter facility that does not have a state or federal
7 inspector on duty and any meat produced from these
8 facilities are not considered state or federally inspected
9 meat products;

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11 ~~(xiii)~~(xiv) "This act" means W.S. 11-49-101
12 through 11-49-104.

14 **11-49-103. Wyoming Food Freedom Act; purpose;**
15 **exemptions; assumption of risk.**

17 (c) Transactions under this act shall:

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19 (v) Not involve the sale of meat products, with
20 the following exceptions:

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1 (G) The sale of meat products pursuant to
2 subsection (n) of this section and subject to subsection
3 (o) of this section.

4
5 (n) Except as prohibited by federal law and subject
6 to subsection (o) of this section, a producer may sell meat
7 products from cattle, sheep, swine or goats raised by the
8 producer that were slaughtered on the premises of the
9 producer or at a custom slaughter facility, if the
10 following conditions are met:

11
12 (i) The meat products are produced from animals
13 that are raised, slaughtered, processed and sold in
14 Wyoming;

15
16 (ii) The meat products are sold directly to an
17 informed end consumer in Wyoming, whether for consumption
18 on or off the premises;

19
20 (iii) A prominent written warning statement
21 shall be delivered to the informed end consumer at the time
22 of sale, or the warning may be displayed on a label affixed

1 to the meat product packaging. The warning required by this
2 paragraph shall state:

3
4 (A) The meat product has not been inspected
5 and is not regulated;

6
7 (B) An informed end consumer who obtains
8 meat products pursuant to this act agrees not to sell,
9 donate or commercially redistribute the meat;

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11 (C) Information describing the standards
12 used by the producer with respect to animal health and in
13 the processing of meat from the animal.

14
15 (iv) The producer shall not publish any
16 statement associated with the meat specified in this
17 subsection that implies the Wyoming department of
18 agriculture's approval or endorsement of meat delivered
19 under this subsection.

20
21 (o) Subsection (n) of this section shall be effective
22 on the date that the governor, on advice of the attorney
23 general, certifies to the secretary of state that the sale

1 of meat products from cattle, sheep, swine or goats raised
2 by the producer that were slaughtered on the premises of
3 the producer or at a custom slaughter facility is legalized
4 under federal law. Legalization under federal law shall be
5 either the passage of a federal law to allow
6 direct-to-consumer sales of uninspected meat products or
7 the issuance of a final decision by a federal court with
8 jurisdiction over this state that declares that the federal
9 prohibition on direct-to-consumer sales is unconstitutional
10 or otherwise invalid. Sales of meat products pursuant to
11 subsection (n) of this section shall be allowed immediately
12 upon the governor's certification to the secretary of state
13 that sales of uninspected meat products have been
14 legalized.

15

16 **Section 2.** The department of agriculture may
17 promulgate any rules necessary to implement the provisions
18 of this act and producers may sell meat products
19 immediately upon certification by the governor that W.S.
20 11-49-103(n) is effective.

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
