Summary/Major Elements:

• This bill requires health insurers and contracted utilization review entities to follow prior authorization regulations that are specified within the bill.

- The bill authorizes "gold carding", where health care providers would be able to forego prior authorization requirements for certain procedures or medications if they reach a specified threshold of approved prior authorization requests.
- The bill requires the Department of Insurance to undergo rulemaking and provides definitions.

Comments:

• Has a Delayed Effective Date of January 1, 2026 for the gold carding section of the bill.
