Subject: Electricity reliability.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill requires the public service commission to establish standards related to electricity reliability and specifies that failing to comply with those standards will subject violators to penalties.
- The bill provides that the public service commission shall not allow for rate recovery for new or modified facilities that are likely to result in failure to comply with reliability standards.
- The bill specifies that it does not prevent public utilities from entering into individualized energy contracts or utilizing customer-specific energy portfolios.
