**Subject:** Large conservation projects approved for funding from the Wyoming Wildlife and Natural Resource Trust.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The Wyoming Legislature has established an account for natural resource conservation and wildlife projects and all projects with a cumulative total grant that exceeds four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00) are considered a large project that must be approved by the Legislature.
- This year's large project bill includes three (3) new projects for the purposes of supporting rangeland restoration, invasive species control, river restoration and stream modification.
- This year's large projects are:
  - Upper Greybull Fish Passage
  - Baggs Valley Headwaters II
  - Seminoe Shirley Habitat

**Comments:**

- This act is commonly known as the "Large Projects Funding Bill".
