**Subject:** Clarifying that certain special-district entities are covered entities under the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The Wyoming Governmental Claims Act generally provides that governmental entities are immune from liability except for specified actions.
- This act clarifies that entities formed by a county memorial hospital, special hospital district, rural health care district and a senior health care district that are wholly owned by one or more governmental entities are covered entities for purposes of the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act.
