Page 1-line 8 After "action;" insert "providing an appropriation for health care to protect the people's welfare;".

Page 6-after line 17 Insert and renumber as necessary:

"Section 3.

(a) To provide for health care to protect the people's welfare, there is appropriated three million eight hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$3,860,000.00) from the general fund and three million eight hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$3,860,000.00) of federal funds to the department of health for purposes of providing payments to home and community-based service providers within the comprehensive waiver unit in the health care financing program. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2026. It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be included in the department of health's standard budget for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

(b) If 2025 Senate File 0001 or 2025 House Bill 0001 is enacted into law, the appropriations in subsection (a) of this section shall be reduced by one dollar (\$1.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00) in general funds and by one dollar (\$1.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00) in federal funds appropriated to the department of health for purposes of providing payments to home and community-based service providers within the comprehensive waiver unit in the health care financing program in 2025 Senate File 0001 or 2025 House Bill 0001."

Page 6-line 19 Delete entirely and renumber as necessary:

"Section 4.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this act is effective July 1, 2025.

(b) Section 3 of this act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution." ANGELOS, LARSEN, L, RODRIGUEZ-WILLIAMS, STYVAR
