"Section 3.

(a) There is appropriated from the public school foundation program account twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000.00) to the school facilities commission for demolition, site preparation and construction necessary for the completion of a high school building and facility project in Campbell county school district #1. Any disposition or demolition of buildings or facilities shall be subject to commission approval and be included in the district's facility plan to ensure the disposition or demolition is in the financial interest of the state and is in the public interest as required under W.S. 21-15-123(f)(vi). The amounts appropriated under this subsection shall remain

in effect from the effective date of this act until the high school building and facility project in Campbell county school district #1 is complete. Upon completion of the high school building and facility project in Campbell county school district #1, any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from the appropriation for the project shall revert to the public school foundation program account.

(b) If 2025 House Bill 0259 is enacted into law, the appropriation in subsection (a) of this section shall be reduced by one dollar (\$1.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00) appropriated to the school facilities commission for the project specified in subsection (a) of this section in 2025 House Bill 0259."

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this act is effective July 1, 2025.
