"(ii) A government entity may transfer personal data to nongovernment entity contracted by the government entity to provide or assist with government services provided by the government entity. Any contract for services with a nongovernment entity shall include requirements for the protection of personal data consistent with this article. Any personal data transferred pursuant to this paragraph shall be returned or destroyed by the nongovernment entity once the personal data is no longer necessary for the provision of the government service. No nongovernment entity shall maintain, sell, transfer, process or otherwise use the personal data in any manner except as necessary to provide the contracted service;".
