Working animal protection act.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to counties, cities and towns; prohibiting
2 counties, cities and towns from enacting and enforcing
3 policies on the use of animals as specified; and providing
4 for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-133 and 18-2-117 are created to
9 read:

11 **15-1-133. Working animal protections.**

12

13 (a) No city or town shall enact an ordinance or
14 policy that terminates, bans or unduly restricts a person

1 from using a working animal in lawful commerce or an animal
2 enterprise.

3
4 (b) This section supersedes any municipal ordinance
5 or policy that conflicts with this section, but shall not
6 supersede:

7
8 (i) Any municipal zoning ordinance enacted under
9 this title;

10
11 (ii) Any municipal ordinance or policy relating
12 to public health or public safety.

13
14 (c) This section shall not be interpreted to amend
15 any other Wyoming law that relates to animal care, public
16 health or public safety, including the provisions of W.S.
17 23-3-109.

18
19 (d) As used in this section, "working animal" means a
20 nonhuman animal used primarily for the purpose of
21 performing a specific duty or function in commerce or an
22 animal enterprise including human service, legal hunting,
23 agriculture, ranching, husbandry, transportation,

1 education, competition, tourism, entertainment or
2 exhibition or that is used primarily for rodeo events,
3 training for rodeo events or participating in rodeo events,
4 whether the event is performed in a rodeo, fair, jackpot,
5 agricultural exhibition or other similar event. The term
6 shall not include rabbits, llamas, cattle, swine, sheep,
7 goats, poultry or any other animal that is used primarily
8 for the production of food or fiber.

10 **18-2-117. Working animal protections.**

11
12 (a) No county shall enact any resolution, ordinance
13 or policy that terminates, bans or unduly restricts a
14 person from using a working animal in lawful commerce or an
15 animal enterprise.

16
17 (b) This section supersedes any resolution, ordinance
18 or policy that conflicts with this section, but shall not
19 supersede:

20
21 (i) Any county zoning resolution enacted under
22 this title;

1 (ii) Any policy relating to public health or
2 public safety.

4 (c) This section shall not be interpreted to amend
5 any other Wyoming law that relates to animal care, public
6 health or public safety, including the provisions of W.S.
7 23-3-109.

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9 (d) As used in this section, "working animal" means a
10 nonhuman animal used primarily for the purpose of
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13 agriculture, ranching, husbandry, transportation,
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16 training for rodeo events or participating in rodeo events,
17 whether the event is performed in a rodeo, fair, jackpot,
18 agricultural exhibition or other similar event. The term
19 shall not include rabbits, llamas, cattle, swine, sheep,
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
