## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle license plates;

- 2 authorizing specially designed license plates to be issued
- 3 to benefit search and rescue efforts; specifying
- 4 requirements; authorizing fees; making conforming
- 5 amendments; specifying applicability; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section 1**. W.S. 31-2-234 is created to read:

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12 31-2-234. Search and rescue license plates.

1	(a) Any person required to register a vehicle in
2	Wyoming pursuant to this article may apply to the
3	department for a statement of eligibility for search and
4	rescue license plates for any motor vehicle that is not a
5	commercial vehicle or multipurpose vehicle owned or leased
6	by that person upon registration of the vehicle. The
7	department may include as part of the application the
8	option for the applicant to donate an additional amount in
9	support of search and rescue activities. Upon payment by
10	the applicant of a fee of one hundred fifty dollars
11	(\$150.00) to the department, plus any additional voluntary
12	amount, the department shall issue a written statement of
13	eligibility for search and rescue license plates. The
14	department shall assess an annual fee of fifty dollars
15	(\$50.00) for a person to retain eligibility for search and
16	rescue license plates, but this annual fee shall not be
17	charged in the year the person pays the one hundred fifty
18	dollars (\$150.00) eligibility fee. The person may submit an
19	additional voluntary amount in support of search and rescue
20	activities when remitting the annual fee.

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22 (b) The fees collected under subsection (a) of this 23 section shall be payable to the department and shall be

accounted for separately. Except as otherwise provided by 1 2 law, the fees collected under subsection (a) of this 3 section shall be distributed to the search and rescue 4 account within the office of homeland security as created in W.S. 19-13-301. Funds distributed to the search and 5 rescue account under this section shall be administered in 6 7 accordance with the following: 8 9 (i) The funds deposited in the search and rescue 10 account under this section are continuously appropriated to 11 the office of homeland security and shall only be used for 12 the purposes provided in W.S. 19-13-301(b) and 13 19-13-301(c); 14 The office of homeland 15 (ii) security 16 establish methods to accept voluntary contributions in 17 support of search and rescue activities for deposit into

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amounts;

22 (iii) The department, in consultation with the 23 Wyoming office of homeland security, is authorized to

the search and rescue account. The office of homeland

security may suggest and solicit specific contribution

1 receive and credit to the search and rescue account, any

2 money or property of any kind or character donated, granted

3 or bequeathed to Wyoming search and rescue activities. The

4 office of homeland security shall have the authority to

5 carry out the terms, if any, of the grant, donation or

6 bequest, or in the absence of any terms or limitations, to

7 expend the money or the proceeds of the property as it may

8 deem advisable for search and rescue activities under the

9 provisions of this section and W.S. 19-13-301.

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11 (c) Applicants shall apply at least thirty (30) days 12 before registration is required for the vehicle for which 13 the plates are intended. Except as provided in this section, application for, issuance and renewal of the 14 15 search and rescue license plates under this section shall 16 be subject to the same requirements and fees as provided in 17 this article in addition to the fee collected under subsection (a) of this section. The license plate fees 18 19 required under W.S. 31-3-102(a)(viii) shall accompany each 20 application. The license plates under this section shall be 21 issued by the county treasurer of each county and shall be

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displayed only upon the vehicle for which they are issued.

1	(d) The department shall prescribe the design of the
2	search and rescue license plates authorized by this section
3	in consultation with the public and other interested
4	parties, which shall include an image of the bucking horse
5	and rider described in W.S. 8-3-117. License plates
6	authorized by this section need not include Arabic numerals
7	designating the county. The department shall arrange for
8	production of the license plates. Following initial
9	approval, search and rescue license plates shall be subject
10	to redesign on the same schedule as all license plates
11	beginning with the year 2033 reissuance.

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13 (e) The department may prepare any special forms and 14 promulgate any rules necessary to carry out this section.

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(f) Unless one thousand (1,000) sets of license plates are issued under this section before December 31, 2032, the plates authorized under this section shall be eliminated from production and the department shall report the cessation of production to the legislature not later than January 15, 2033.

1 Section 2. W.S. 19-13-301(a) and by creating a new 2 subsection (d), 31-2-212, 31-2-225(a) by creating a new 3 paragraph (vii) and 31-3-101 by creating a new subsection 4 (k) are amended to read: 5 6 19-13-301. Search and rescue account; created; 7 expenditures. 8 9 (a) The search and rescue account is created. Fees 10 identified in W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-201, 31-2-234, 31-2-404, 31-2-409, 31-2-703, 41-13-109 and 41-13-110 shall be 11 12 deposited in the state treasury to the credit of this 13 account. 14 15 (d) The state treasurer is hereby authorized and 16 directed to receive and credit to the search and rescue 17 account any grant, donation or bequest that is made to the search and rescue account for the purposes provided by W.S. 18 19 31-2-234. The state treasurer shall invest any money 20 received under this subsection in accordance with law and 21 the investment earnings received thereon shall be deposited

into the search and rescue account.

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1 31-2-212. Loss, mutilation or destruction of

2 registration, plates or validation stickers.

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Upon loss, mutilation or destruction of a certificate of 4 5 registration, license plate, or validation sticker the owner of a vehicle may obtain a duplicate certificate of 6 registration, new license plates or validation stickers 7 8 from any county treasurer or the department if the vehicle 9 was registered or plates or stickers were issued by the 10 department upon application showing the loss, mutilation or 11 destruction, return of mutilated plates or stickers and payment of the duplicate registration, plate or sticker 12 13 fee. For those vehicles registered under the provisions of 14 31-2-213(h), 31-2-215 through 31-2-223, 31-2-226, 31-2-227 or 31-2-229 through  $\frac{31-2-233}{31-2-234}$  replacement 15 16 duplicate license plates may be obtained upon application 17 with the county treasurer from which the original plates were purchased or the department if applicable, accompanied 18 19 by fees as provided by W.S. 31-3-102(a)(vi)(C). Duplicate 20 license plates obtained under this section to replace lost 21 or stolen plates shall not be displayed on the vehicle until the validation stickers on the lost or stolen plates 22 have expired. Upon loss, mutilation or destruction of a 23

- 1 dealer plate or validation sticker the dealer may obtain a
- 2 replacement dealer plate or validation sticker from the
- 3 county treasurer from which he purchased the original plate
- 4 in the same manner as the owner of a vehicle and upon
- 5 payment of the appropriate fee under W.S. 31-3-102(a)(vi).
- 6 Obtaining a replacement plate is not the purchase of an
- 7 additional plate under W.S. 31-16-125(b)(i). Upon
- 8 application for new license plates or stickers the county
- 9 treasurer shall notify the department and the county
- 10 sheriff as soon as possible of the loss, mutilation or
- 11 destruction. The department shall notify the appropriate
- 12 law enforcement agencies of any loss, mutilation or
- 13 destruction of license plates or stickers.

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7	(k) Any owner of a vehicle who wishes to donate money
8	to provide for search and rescue efforts under W.S.
9	31-2-234 shall be provided space on the registration form
10	to do so pursuant to W.S. 31-2-225(a)(vii). Revenues
11	collected under this subsection shall be forwarded by the
12	county treasurer to the state treasurer to be deposited
13	into the search and rescue account created by W.S.
14	<u>19-13-301.</u>
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16	Section 3. The department of transportation shall
17	make search and rescue account license plates available
18	beginning on January 1, 2026.
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20	Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
