A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; clarifying that the false
2 voting statute includes out-of-state voting; authorizing
3 the secretary of state to request an investigation; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-26-106(a)(iv) and (e) is amended
9 to read:

11 **22-26-106. False voting.**

13 (a) False voting consists of performing any of the
14 following acts in connection with or related to the
15 election process or an election:

1

(iv) Voting, or offering to vote, more than once in an election, including voting more than once in a Wyoming election, or voting in any other state and then voting, or offering to vote, in Wyoming for the same federal election.

(e) The county sheriff shall investigate acts of false voting at the request of the secretary of state or a county clerk who has reasonable cause to believe that a person has committed false voting. After an investigation and a finding that the allegation has merit, the county sheriff shall refer the matter to the district attorney for prosecution in the appropriate courts of this state.
