Summary/Major Elements:

This act requires the Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board (Board) to create an
alternative certification of teachers, which is limited to the subject areas and grade levels an
applicant has successfully completed.

To be eligible for an alternative certification under this act, a person must have a bachelor's
degree from an accredited college or university and have successfully completed an accredited
or nonaccredited alternative certification program or pathway approved by the Board. The
accredited or nonaccredited alternative certification program must, at a minimum, require
passage of a subject area examination, pedagogy examination, United States Constitution
examination, and Wyoming Constitution examination.
