**"6-2-512. Assault and threats of violence against health care providers; battery against health care providers; penalties.**

(a) As used in this section:

(i) "Assault" means an offense under W.S. 6-2-501(a);

(ii) "Battery" means an offense under W.S. 6-2-501(b);

(iii) "Health care provider" means as defined in W.S. 7-13-1501(m) (iv);

(iv) "Threat of violence" means an express or implied threat where the person:

(A) Threatens to commit an offense involving bodily injury, death or property damage of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more and acts with intent to cause property damage of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more or acts with intent to place another person in fear of imminent bodily injury, serious bodily injury or death; or

(B) Makes a threat, accompanied by a show of immediate force or violence, to do bodily injury to another person.

(b) A person is guilty of assault against a health care provider if the person:

(i) Commits an assault against a health care provider;

(ii) Knows or reasonably should know that the person is a health care provider at the time of the assault; and

(iii) The health care provider was performing duties within the scope of the provider's authority or employment as a health care provider at the time of the assault.

(c) A person is guilty of a threat of violence against a health care provider if the person:

(i) Makes a threat of violence against a health care provider;

(ii) Knows or reasonably should know that the person is a health care provider at the time of the threat of violence; and

(iii) The health care provider was performing duties within the scope of the provider's authority or employment as a health care provider at the time of the threat of violence.

(d) A person is guilty of battery against a health care provider if the person:

(i) Commits a battery against a health care provider;

(ii) Knows or reasonably should know that the person is a health care provider at the time of the battery; and

(iii) The health care provider was performing duties within the scope of their authority or employment as a health care provider at the time of the battery.

(e) A person who violates subsections (b), (c) or (d) of this section is:

(i) For a first offense, guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not less than two (2) days and not more than six (6) months, a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both;

(ii) For a second or subsequent offense, guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not less than forty-five (45) days and not more than three (3) years, a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.". YIN
