"(f) A parent or guardian of a minor may provide written consent to the public library that the minor has permission to access sexually explicit materials that are cataloged, located and stored in a section of the library as required by paragraph (a)(ii) of this section.

(g) No minor shall have access to any materials that are provided by the public library online without the parent or guardian of the minor providing written consent to the public library that the minor has permission to access those online materials. Each public library shall provide written notice to the parent or guardian of a minor that materials that are provided by the public library online are not reviewed to determine whether those materials are sexually explicit materials.".

Page 7-line 5 After "district" insert ", unless the student's parent or guardian provides written consent to the library of the school where the student is enrolled that the student has permission to access sexually explicit materials in the library".

Page 7-line 7 After "(c)" insert "Each school district board of trustees shall create a group of persons, who reside within the geographical boundaries of the school

district, to evaluate materials to determine whether those materials are sexually explicit materials by using the nationally recognized film rating system."

Page 9-after line 15 Insert and renumber as necessary:

"(f) No student who is younger than age eighteen (18) shall have access to any materials that are provided by the library of the school where the student is enrolled online without the parent or guardian of the student providing written consent to the library that the student has permission to access those online materials. Each library shall provide written notice to the parent or guardian of a student that materials that are provided by the library online are not reviewed to determine whether those materials are sexually explicit materials.".
