Eligibility for veterans property tax exemption-amendments.

Sponsored By: Representative(s) Connolly, Davis, Filer, Neiman and Posey and Senator(s) Barlow, Cooper and Pappas

AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; providing an ad valorem tax exemption for bona fide Wyoming residents who are honorably discharged veterans who served in the United States armed forces or the Wyoming national guard for a specified time period; providing an ad valorem tax exemption for bona fide Wyoming residents who are active or reserve members of the Wyoming national guard or the United States armed forces; providing an ad valorem tax exemption for bona fide Wyoming residents who are surviving spouses or surviving parents of specified veterans and military members; amending the bona fide Wyoming residency requirement as specified; providing definitions; specifying applicability; and providing for an effective date.

"**Section 1.** W.S. 39-13-105(a) by creating new paragraphs (viii) through (xi), (f) and by creating a new subsection (n) is amended to read:".

Page 2-line 9 Reinsert stricken "at least three (3) three years" and delete "not less than one".

Page 2-line 10 Delete "(1) year".

"(n) Beginning July 1, 2027, there is annually appropriated five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve account, or as much thereof as is necessary, to the state treasurer's office for purposes of reimbursing counties for exemptions under this section only if insufficient funds are available from the state treasurer's office biennial appropriation for the same purpose. If the state treasurer determines the amount appropriated in this section may be insufficient to make reimbursement for all counties during the year, the available monies shall be prorated among the counties entitled to reimbursement at an amount not less than one hundred percent (100%). The state treasurer's office, with approval by the governor, shall provide the notice required under W.S. 9-2-1005(b)(ii)(A) and (B) for any expenditure under this section in excess of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) and the state treasurer shall recommend any revisions to both the biennial appropriation and the annual appropriation under this section in the budget requests submitted under W.S. 9-2-1013."
