A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of the government;
2 establishing qualifications for specified public offices;
3 specifying that sex offenders are ineligible to hold those
4 public offices; providing definitions; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-104 is created to read:

10

11 **9-1-104. Qualifications for office; ineligibility of**
12 **candidates convicted of certain sex offenses.**

13

14 (a) In addition to any other qualifications to hold
15 public office, no sex offender shall be eligible to be a

1 candidate for, or be appointed to, any of the following
2 offices:

4 (i) Trustee of a school district;

5

6 (ii) Community college district board member;

7

8 (iii) County attorney or district attorney;

9

10 (iv) County commissioner;

11

12 (v) Member of the governing body of a city or
13 town;

14

15 (vi) Mayor of a city or town;

16

17 (vii) County sheriff.

18

19 (b) The secretary of state, county clerk or other
20 appropriate election official shall refuse to certify a
21 candidate's name if the candidate is ineligible to hold
22 public office under this section. If a person in office is
23 disqualified from office under this section, the office

1 shall be deemed vacant as provided in W.S.
2 22-18-101(a)(iv).

3

4 (c) As used in this section, "sex offender" means a
5 person who is currently registered on the central registry
6 of offenders under W.S. 7-19-301 through 7-19-310.

7

8 **Section 2.** This act shall apply to any person elected
9 or appointed to public office on or after July 1, 2026.

10

11 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
