State funded capital construction.

Sponsored by: Joint Appropriations Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state funded capital construction; providing
2 definitions; providing appropriations for purposes related to
3 state funded capital construction and major maintenance; making
4 appropriations subject to terms and conditions as specified;
5 amending prior appropriations; and providing for an effective
6 date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.**

11

12 (a) As used in this act:

13

14 (i) "Appropriation" means the authorizations granted by
15 the legislature under this act to make expenditures from and to

1 incur obligations against the general and other funds as
2 specified;

3

4 (ii) "FF" means federal funds;

5

6 (iii) "Major maintenance" means as defined by W.S.
7 9-2-3001(b)(ix);

8

9 (iv) "PR" means private funding sources;

10

11 (v) "SR" means an agency's account within the special
12 revenue fund;

13

14 (vi) "S0" means other funds identified by footnote;

15

16 (vii) "This appropriation," when used in a footnote in
17 this act, shall be construed as a reference to that portion of the
18 appropriated funds identified in the footnote.

19

20 (b) Appropriations for projects in this act remain in effect
21 until the project is completed, unless otherwise provided. The
22 amounts appropriated for projects in this act shall be expended
23 only on the projects specified and any unexpended, unobligated

1 funds remaining upon completion of a project shall revert to the
2 accounts from which they were appropriated, unless otherwise
3 provided. The amounts appropriated in this act are intended to
4 provide a maximum amount for each project from any source,
5 excluding contingency funding, and shall not be construed to be an
6 entitlement or guaranteed amount. This subsection shall not apply
7 to appropriations for major maintenance in this act, except as
8 specifically provided.

14 (a) The following sums of money are appropriated for the
15 capital construction projects specified:

(iv) Wyoming community college commission - health science facility at Casper college.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, after funds are obligated for all studies specified in subsection (a) of this footnote, any remaining unobligated funds from this appropriation are authorized for expenditure on any level I, level II and master plan studies approved by the state building commission.

2. The state construction department is authorized to retain a qualified owner's representative for the veterans' home of Wyoming remodel. From this general fund appropriation, the department may expend an amount not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for retention of the qualified owner's representative.

3. (a) Federal funds received by the state of Wyoming for state run veterans' home facilities shall:

(i) Be deposited to the legislative stabilization reserve account in an equivalent amount of expended general funds to the extent funds from this appropriation have been expended; and

1 (ii) Reduce this appropriation by one dollar (\$1.00) for each one
 2 dollar (\$1.00) in federal funds for any remaining federal funds received in
 3 excess of the amount deposited to the legislative stabilization reserve account
 4 in accordance with this footnote.

6

7 (a) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2026, and
8 subject to W.S. 9-4-207(d)(iv), there is appropriated two
9 hundred thirty-three million three hundred fifty-four
10 thousand nine hundred forty-three dollars (\$233,354,943.00)
11 from the general fund for major maintenance to the entities
12 and in the amounts specified as provided in this
13 subsection. This appropriation shall be distributed as
14 follows:
15

16 (i) Thirty-seven and six tenths percent (37.6%)
17 to the state construction department for state buildings,
18 facilities and sites managed by the state building
19 commission and state institutions;
20

21 (ii) Seven and ninety-nine hundredths percent
22 (7.99%) to the department of state parks and cultural
23 resources to fund major maintenance requests submitted by

1 the department of state parks and cultural resources as
2 approved by the state building commission;

3

4 (iii) Thirty-six and thirty-four hundredths
5 percent (36.34%) to the University of Wyoming for
6 university buildings, facilities and sites, excluding
7 student housing, the student union and auxiliary services
8 areas, the latter being those areas funded by university
9 self-sustaining revenues;

10

11 (iv) Eighteen and seven hundredths percent
12 (18.07%) to the state construction department for community
13 college district buildings, facilities and sites.

18 **Section 4.**

19

20 (a) 2023 Session Laws, Chapter 187, Section 10(a) by
21 creating a new paragraph (iv) and by creating a new
22 subsection (c) is amended to read:

1 **Section 10.**

2

3 (a) There is appropriated an amount not to
4 exceed ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from
5 the Wyoming state penitentiary capital
6 construction account to the state construction
7 department for, in consultation with the
8 department of corrections:

9

10 (iv) Acquiring land for a future state
11 penitentiary under subsection (c) of this
12 section.

13

14 (c) Prior to the acquisition of land under
15 2023 Session Laws, Chapter 187, Section
16 10(a)(iv), as amended, the state construction
17 department shall consult with the office of state
18 lands and investments and the department of
19 corrections to identify and evaluate potential
20 land acquisitions taking into account location,
21 price, geotechnical conditions, soil quality and
22 any other factors determined relevant by the
23 department of corrections and the office of state

1 lands and investments. Any land acquisitions
2 under this section shall be subject to approval
3 of the state building commission.
4

5 (b) 2023 Session Laws, Chapter 187, Section 10(b) is
6 repealed.

7

8 [WYOMING STATE SHOOTING COMPLEX]

9

10 **Section 5.**

11

12 (a) As used in this section, "Wyoming state shooting
13 complex" means a facility located in Park county, near
14 Cody, that is described in the state shooting complex
15 development and oversight task force final recommendation
16 that was submitted to the governor, the joint
17 appropriations committee and the joint travel, recreation,
18 wildlife and cultural resources interim committee, dated
19 August 8, 2024.

20

21 (b) From the unexpended, unobligated balance of the
22 state shooting complex account appropriated under 2023
23 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 146, Section 3(a)(ii) and the

1 expenditure of which requires additional action of the
2 legislature, up to two million five hundred thousand
3 dollars (\$2,500,000.00), or as much thereof as is
4 available, is hereby authorized for expenditure in
5 accordance with this section.

6

7 (c) From the unexpended, unobligated balance of the
8 state shooting complex account appropriated under 2023
9 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 146, Section 3(a)(iii) and
10 the expenditure of which requires additional action of the
11 legislature, up to two million five hundred thousand
12 dollars (\$2,500,000.00), or as much thereof as is
13 available, is hereby authorized for expenditure in
14 accordance with this section.

15

16 (d) Notwithstanding 2023 Wyoming Session Laws,
17 Chapter 146, Section 3(b), funds authorized for expenditure
18 under this section shall be expended, without delay and as
19 directed by the Wyoming state shooting complex joint powers
20 board through the department of state parks and cultural
21 resources, for costs related to the Wyoming state shooting
22 complex that are described in and subject to the terms of a
23 memorandum of understanding between the Wyoming state

1 shooting complex joint powers board and the department of
2 state parks and cultural resources executed on September 3,
3 2025.

4

5 (e) Funds authorized for expenditure under this
6 section shall not be transferred or expended for any other
7 purpose. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-
8 4-207, the authority to expend funds under this section
9 shall remain in effect and not lapse at the end of the
10 fiscal period except upon further legislative action. Funds
11 authorized for expenditure under this section shall be
12 reduced by one dollar (\$1.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00)
13 appropriated to the state shooting complex account in 2026
14 House Bill 0001, if enacted into law.

15

16 (f) Any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining in
17 the state shooting complex account from appropriations
18 under 2023 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 146, Section 3(a)
19 and not otherwise authorized for expenditure under this
20 section shall revert to the accounts from which they were
21 appropriated.
