Source of revenue increase:

The bill would generate an estimated revenue increase in the form of licensing application and renewal fees for internationally trained physicians.

Assumptions:

The Board of Medicine assumes the estimated revenue increase based on one applicant in Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 and two applicants in FY 2028 and FY 2029. The Board of Medicine assumes 90 percent of license holders renew their licenses each year. Current license application fees are \$400, and renewal fees are \$155 for physicians. The Board of Medicine assumes internationally trained physician fees would be the same rate as current physician fees, resulting in estimated revenue increases of \$400 in FY 2027, \$955 in FY 2028, and \$1,110 in FY 2029.

**NOTICE-AGENCY ESTIMATE OF ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACT REQUESTED**
