Catch Title: **Carrying of concealed weapons-age requirement.**

Subject: Amending concealed carry permit requirements for persons age eighteen (18) to twenty-one (21).

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law provides requirements for a person to be issued a concealed-carry permit. Among those requirements is that a person be at least age twenty-one (21) to receive a concealed-carry permit.
- This act amends the age requirement for a concealed-carry permit to require a person to be age eighteen (18) to receive a permit.
- This act repeals obsolete provisions related to the issuance of concealed-carry permits to persons between age eighteen (18) and age twenty-one (21).
