**Subject:** Voting machine and voting system tests.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill clarifies the procedure for testing voting machines and electronic voting systems, including public notice requirements and the presence of representatives and members of the public during testing.
- Specifies that all voting machines and electronic voting systems must be individually tested and prepared for elections.
- Removes the presumption of proper preparation of voting machines and allows challenges to machine preparation within five (5) days after sealing.
- Requires the public posting of test results and retention of test materials and ballots.
