**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This act requires the Wyoming Department of Transportation to conduct a study on transitioning to next-generation 911 services, including recommendations for governance, operations, expenses, efficiencies and funding of next-generation 911, with a report due to the Joint Corporations, Elections and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee by September 1, 2027.
- The act also authorizes the Department of Transportation to establish a grant program to provide grants to governing bodies to address funding shortfalls for the operation of current 911 systems.
- The act appropriates funds for purposes of both conducting the study and providing grants to governing bodies under the grant program.

**Comments:**

- Requires a report on next-generation 911 services to the Joint Corporations, Elections and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee by September 1, 2027.
