Catch Title: **Keeping amateurism in high school athletics.**

Subject: Amateurism requirements for high school athletics.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill establishes amateur status requirements for students participating in Wyoming high school sports or activities sanctioned by the Wyoming High School Activities Association.
- The bill specifies conditions under which a student forfeits amateur status, including accepting monetary compensation, receiving awards exceeding approved value or signing professional contracts.
- Provides exceptions that do not result in forfeiture of amateur status, including receiving necessary expenses, participating in certain fundraising activities or accepting scholarships.
- Provides that violations of amateur status requirements result in ineligibility to participate in the concerned sport or activity.
