Agenda Item #2 - Update on School Facilities Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The School Facilities Commission (SFC) has been acting to revise its rules and regulations. The proposed changes to the rules and regulations accomplish the following goals:

1. Simplify;
2. Clarify;
3. Reduce the length, and;
4. Delete repetition of statute language.

The draft of the proposed SFC Rules and Regulations was developed with the assistance of counsel from the Attorney General's Office and the State Construction Department (SCD).

Action Timeline for Proposed Rules and Regulations Revisions:

- May 2, 2018 – SFC reviewed and discussed
- May 3, 2018 - SFC approved the SCD to present proposed rules to The Select Committee on School Facilities (Select Committee) for review and consultation
- June 8, 2018 - Select Committee reviewed
- June 27, 2018 – SFC reviewed and discussed
- June 28, 2018 - SFC approved the SCD to proceed with the rule making process
- July 11, 2018 – Filed the Notice of Intent with the Secretary of State's Office
- August 31, 2018 – Public comment period ended
- *September 18, 2018 – Potential SFC Public Hearing (Cody)*
- *September 19 – 20, 2018 – SFC consideration of public comments and possible action*

The Notice of Intent to promulgate rules and the opportunity for public comment was advertised in the *Casper Star Tribune* and the *Wyoming Tribune Eagle*. The proposed rules were available for public comment on the Secretary of State's and the State Construction Department's websites.
