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1	37-2-133. Exemption for purchase of coal fired
2	generation facilities that would otherwise have been retired;
3	public utility purchase requirements; conditions for
4	exemption.
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6	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
7	provisions of this chapter and chapters 1 and 3 of this title
8	shall not apply to a person who operates a coal fired electric
9	generation facility purchased under an agreement approved by
10	the commission under W.S. 37-3-117.
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12	(f) A person purchasing an otherwise retiring coal
13	fired electric generation facility may sell electricity
14	generated by the facility directly to customers that take
15	service at the transmission level.

17	(g) Consistent with federal law, transmission providers
18	in Wyoming shall offer unbundled transmission service to any
19	retail customer who purchases electricity generated by an
20	otherwise retiring coal fired electric generation facility.
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1	37-3-117. Limitation for recovery of costs associated
2	with electric generation built to replace retiring coal fired
3	generation facility.
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5	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
6	chapter <u>:</u> -
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8	(i) Any electric public utility seeking to retire
9	a coal fired electric generation facility shall first make a
10	good faith effort to sell the facility for continued use as
11	a coal fired electric generation facility.
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14	STAFF COMMENT
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	The Committee may wish to consider whether the requirement
16	that a company offer to sell the facility or set the price
17	at net salvage value may implicate the constitutional
18	provision prohibiting the taking of private property for
19	public or private use without just compensation. Article 1,
20	§ 33 of the Wyoming Constitution reads: "Private property
21	shall not be taken or damaged for public or private use
22	without just compensation."

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13	Section 2. This act shall apply to coal fired electric
14	generation facilities retiring on or after July 1, 2020.
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16	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2020.
