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7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. W.S. 28-11-601 is created to read:

1 2 28-11-601. Appointment of members; powers and duties; 3 executive branch liaisons. 4 5 (a) Not later than March 15 following each general election, a select committee on blockchain, financial 6 technology and digital innovation shall be appointed subject 7 8 to the following: 9 10 (i) The president of the senate shall appoint three (3) members of the senate apportioned as nearly as possible 11 12 to reflect the percentage of the elected membership of the 13 majority and minority parties of the senate, provided not more than two (2) of the members shall be from the same 14 political party. The president of the senate shall designate 15 16 a co-chair of the select committee; 17 18 The speaker of the house of representatives (ii) 19 shall appoint three (3) members of the house apportioned as 20 nearly as possible to reflect the percentage of the elected 21 membership of the majority and minority parties of the house, provided not more than two (2) of the members shall be from 22

The speaker of the house shall designate a co-chair of the select committee. 2 3 4 (b) The select committee shall: 5 Develop knowledge and expertise among its б (i) members regarding issues pertaining to blockchain, financial 7 8 technology and digital innovation; 9 10 (ii) Develop and introduce legislation as necessary to promote blockchain, financial technology and 11 12 digital innovation in Wyoming. 13 (c) Not later than March 15 following each general 14 election, the governor shall appoint three (3) persons to 15 16 serve as liaisons to the select committee on blockchain, 17 financial technology and digital innovation. The governor may, in a manner consistent with W.S. 9-1-202, remove any 18 19 liaison to the select committee. The liaisons shall: 20 21 (i) Aid, assist and advise the select committee on issues pertaining to blockchain, financial technology and 22

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1 2 (ii) Except as otherwise provided in this 3 paragraph, serve without salary but may, at the governor's 4 discretion, receive per diem and mileage or actual expenses for attending meetings in the manner and amounts provided by 5 law for state employees. Members who are government employees 6 shall be considered on official business of their agency when 7 8 performing duties as liaisons to the select committee. 9 10 Section 2. 11 12 (a) Within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act: 13 14 15 (i) The president of the senate and the speaker of 16 the house shall appoint members to the initial select committee on blockchain, financial technology and digital 17 innovation in accordance with the requirements of W.S. 18 19 28-11-601(a), as created by this act; 20 21 (ii) The governor shall appoint liaisons to the initial select committee on blockchain, financial technology 22

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1 and digital innovation in accordance with the requirements of 2 W.S. 28-11-601(c), as created by this act. 3 4 Section 3. 5 6 (a) There is appropriated thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative service 7 8 office. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning 9 with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2022. 10 This appropriation shall only be expended for salary, mileage and per diem of legislative members appointed to the select 11 12 committee on blockchain, financial technology and digital 13 innovation and for other expenses of the select committee as authorized by the management council. Notwithstanding any 14 15 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 16 17 unobligated unexpended, funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 18 19 2022.

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(b) There is appropriated ten thousand dollars
(\$10,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's office.
This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the

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1 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2022. This 2 appropriation shall only be expended for per diem and mileage 3 or actual expenses of liaisons appointed to the select 4 committee on blockchain, financial technology and digital innovation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 5 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 6 7 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 8 from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on 9 June 30, 2022.

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Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
