8 Subject to subsections (b), and (c) and (d) of this 9 section and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, each 10 sportsman licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201 11 shall purchase a single conservation stamp for twelve dollars 12 (\$12.00) which shall be valid for the time period specified 13 in commission rules not to exceed twelve (12) months. stamp or an authorization signifying purchase of the stamp 14 15 shall be in the possession of any person exercising rights 16 under any fishing or hunting license issued pursuant to W.S. 17 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201. Holders of special limited fishing permits issued under W.S. 23-2-207 and holders of 18 19 licenses only under W.S. 23-1-302(q), 23-2-101(j)(v) and 20 (vi), 23-2-201(d)(vi), (vii) and (ix), 23-2-201(f) and 23-2-201(f)21 201(g) are exempt from the provisions of this section when 22 exercising hunting or fishing privileges provided under those

Travel centers. 15 16 17 (a) The transportation commission and the director of the department of transportation shall ensure that all 18 owned or the 19 buildings controlled by department 20 transportation and utilized as travel centers are directed 21 and operated by one (1) or more agencies appointed by the transportation commission for the best interests of all 22

Wyoming people. For purposes of this section an agency may be

1 defined as a chamber of commerce, or any state or local 2 entity. If agency is governmental no appointed, the 3 commission shall direct and operate the travel centers. 4 (b) The department of transportation, in consultation 5 with the commission, shall establish at one (1) or more travel 6 7 center facilities to accept donations in support of wildlife 8 conservation efforts related to the transportation system. Revenues collected under this subsection shall be deposited 9 10 into the wildlife conservation account created under W.S. 31-2-231(b). In carrying out the requirements of this 11 12 subsection, the department may enter into agreements with 13 financial institutions or persons operating remote electronic terminals for the collection of donations. 14 15 16 31-2-231. Wildlife conservation license plates; 17 wildlife conservation account. 18 19 The fees collected under subsection (a) of this 20 section shall be payable to the department and shall be 21 accounted for separately. The fees collected under subsection (a) of this section and revenues collected under 22

W.S. 23-2-101(p), 23-2-201(h), 23-2-306(d), 24-1-131(b) and

1	36-4-121(t) shall be distributed to the wildlife conservation
2	account within the state highway fund, which is hereby
3	created. Funds in the wildlife conservation account shall
4	only be used to provide for wildlife conservation efforts
5	related to the transportation system, including signage,
6	wildlife corridors, wildlife crossings and game fences.

8	36-4-121. Permits to use state parks, recreation areas
9	and historic sites.

11	(t) The department shall include as part of the
12	opportunity to purchase a permit that allows use of state
13	parks, recreation areas, archeological sites and historic
14	sites the option for a permittee to donate an additional
15	amount in support of wildlife conservation efforts related to
16	the transportation system. Revenues collected under this
17	subsection shall be deposited into the wildlife conservation
18	account created by W.S. 31-2-231(b).
