COLEMAN SWORN IN TO REPRESENT HOUSE DISTRICT 30

CHEYENNE – Kathy Coleman of Sheridan was sworn in as a member of the 61st Wyoming Legislature on Monday at 10 a.m. in Cheyenne in the House Chambers of the Wyoming Capitol. Wyoming Supreme Court Justice Barton Voigt administered the oath of office and Representative Ed Buchanan, Speaker of the Wyoming House of Representatives presided over the ceremony.

Rep. Coleman was joined by members of the Wyoming Legislature, legislative staff and family members at the brief ceremony.

Following the administration of the oath of office from Justice Voigt, Speaker Buchanan and fellow legislators welcomed Rep. Coleman to the Wyoming Legislature. Rep. Coleman addressed the well-wishers during the ceremony stating that she looks forward to serving the people of Wyoming.

“I am truly honored to be in this position and was truly honored to be considered. I’m very excited and I look forward to being a part of this body.” Coleman said after the ceremony.

Coleman was appointed by the Sheridan County Commissioners to serve the residents of House District 30 on Oct. 3 to fill the vacant seat left by former Rep. Jonathan Botten who resigned Sept. 10.

Speaker Buchanan has made the following changes to the House Committee assignments, as a result of Rep. Botten’s resignation: Rep. Coleman will serve on the House Travel, Recreation, Wildlife and Cultural Resources Committee and the House Transportation, Highways and Military Affairs Committee. Representative Allen Jaggi will replace Botten on the Wyoming Court Security Commission. – **END** –
