4 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-901(b) and  
7 40-12-501(a)(vii)(intro) are amended to read:

9 **6-3-901. Unauthorized use of personal identifying**  
10 **information; penalties; restitution.**

11

12 (b) As used in this section "personal identifying  
13 information," means the name, ~~address, telephone number,~~

1 ~~driver's license number, social security number, place of~~  
2 ~~employment, employee identification number, tribal~~  
3 ~~identification card number, mother's maiden name, demand~~  
4 ~~deposit account number, savings account number, or credit~~  
5 ~~card number~~ or any of the following data elements of an  
6 individual person::-

8 (i) Address;

9

10 (ii) Telephone number;

11

12 (iii) Social security number;

13

14 (iv) Driver's license number;

15

16 (v) Account number, credit card number or debit  
17 card number in combination with any security code, access  
18 code or password that would allow access to a financial  
19 account of the person;

21 (vi) Tribal identification card;

22

1           (vii) Federal or state government issued  
2 identification card;

3  
4           (viii) Shared secrets, security tokens or  
5 knowledge based authentication;

6  
7           (ix) A username or email address, in combination  
8 with a password or security question and answer that would  
9 permit access to an online account;

10  
11           (x) A birth, death or marriage certificate;

12  
13           (xi) Medical information including, but not  
14 limited to, a person's medical history, mental or physical  
15 condition, or medical treatment or diagnosis by a health  
16 care professional;

17  
18           (xii) Health insurance information including,  
19 but not limited to, a person's health insurance policy  
20 number or subscriber identification number, any unique  
21 identifier used by a health insurer to identify the person

1 or any information in a person's application and claims  
2 history;

3  
4 (xiii) Unique biometric data such as  
5 fingerprints, voice print, retina or iris images, or any  
6 other unique physical representation or digital  
7 representation of biometric data;

8  
9 (xiv) An individual taxpayer identification  
10 number.

12 **40-12-501. Definitions.**

14 (a) As used in this act:

15

16 (vii) "Personal identifying information" means  
17 the first name or first initial and last name of a person  
18 in combination with one (1) or more of the ~~following~~ data  
19 elements specified in W.S. 6-3-901(b), when either the name  
20 or the data elements are not redacted.÷

1           **Section 2.** W.S. 40-12-501(a)(vii)(A) through (E) is  
2 repealed.

3

4           **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
